Following are the notes made of the different ideas, solutions, and opinions expressed.

Courts in SoCal have tried designating courts for play according to rating. This has caused bad blood in every case. A court host has proven to be effective – someone charged with being present during club hours to facilitate play.

Beginner court is a must but if not used can be utilized by other ratings. Designate 1 court as a public court – they must observe the rotation like anyone else but they don't have to be members of the club

Designate 6 courts with 4 on 4 off rotation Designate 6 courts with 2 on 2 off rotation Designate all courts with 2 on 2 off rotation Designate all courts with 4 on 4 off rotation

Designate 6 courts as 'competitive' and 6 courts as 'recreational'

Make sure that at least 1 of 6 courts is a challenge court Do away with challenge courts

Designate 1 day per week as beginners day. Designate 1 day a week for players without partners.

Have 1 white board for every 6 court configuration

Singles play – designate a court – designate day(s). Singles play – let them sign up on the whiteboard with an (s) by their two names and they play 1 game and rotate off.

Donation box for visitors and members.

Junior program

Intro to pickleball several times a month, organized and run by club member(s).
