Board of Directors Meeting May 18, 2023

The Board of Directors Meeting for Sunrise Pickleball Club (SPC) was called to order at 4:30 pm at Rusch Park, Room 2.

A motion was made to approve the May board meeting minutes. It passed unanimously and will be posted to the club website.

Treasurer: Taxes are finished for 2022. 2023 is right on track and looking good. Gwen motioned to pass to pay the accountant \$450 to file our taxes. It passed with a unanimous vote.

If we continue to do events, it would be good to consider a secondary PayPal account for the individuals running the tournaments. Reine said it would be very straightforward to add another account. The board will consider for future events.

Gail proposed the idea of changing the club to a 501-C designation to be able to approach corporations for large sums of money for big future projects.

Communications: There have been member complaints about members playing with non-members. The board will send out letters to repeat offenders and remind them of the rules. Teaching pros were also discussed. Pros may reserve courts, but if the reservation isn't canceled 24 hours before a no use session, the pro will be charged a rental fee.

King and Queen of the court will take a break for the summer. The board wants to send a survey to members to gather information about people volunteering to run King and Queen and other programs in the future.

General Business: The possibility of the board purchasing an ice machine was discussed. The board decided that it would be more of a hassle to have it. The club needs a tournament director and a volunteer coordinator. Both positions would be added to the board and attend meetings.
